Competition Changes - To run an efficient feis, the feis committee reserves the right to cap, combine, split, or cancel competitions if registration numbers are too low to run a separate competition at all levels.

Photography/Video - Video or Photography of any kind that has the capability of capturing a dancer's image while in motion is STRICTLY FORBIDDEN, except in the Pre-Beginner and Beginner categories.

Tabulation - via Feisweb. Marks will be provided for all comps except Pre-Beginner. Prelim and Open comps will get their marks at the feis. Grade results will be available online at feisweb.com under "My Grade Results."

Perpetual trophies - Winners of these awards are responsible for all associated costs including engraving and shipping. Trophies MUST be returned to feis prior to 8am day of feis.

New for 2024: 3-Round Advanced Adult Championship

An Advanced Adult dancer is anyone age 18 or older who has previously placed in the top 3 of a Prelim Championship or competed in Open Champ levels in the youth/&over levels regardless of when the competitor was active. An Advanced Adult dancer has opted to leave youth/&over categories, and once the dancer begins competing as an Advanced Adult, the dancer may not return to the youth/&over categories. For the set round, a set of choice will be performed.
